Hundredths (0.00 to 0.09) .....	8
Thousandths (0.000 to 0.009) .....	9

## Instructions for DIY making

- Photocopy each page of arrow cards onto different coloured paper, laminate, then cut out leaving a 25 mm edge around the cards. Store each set in a snap lock bag and label using a black permanent marker.
- Whole numbers (set of 40 cards): ones - blue; tens - red; hundreds - yellow; thousands - green.
- Decimal numbers (set of 50 cards): ones with dp - blue; tenths - red; hundredths - yellow; thousandths - green.
- Grouping: One set of cards per pair
