

Hundred Chart Window Spin: Worksheet

WHAT YOU NEED (per student)

- This worksheet '**Hundred Chart Window Spin Worksheet**'
- Lead pencil
- Three 'Hundred Chart Windows'**: orange (window 1), blue (window 2), green (window 3).

AIM: To reconstruct a hundred chart by writing all 100 missing numbers using all three windows.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Pick your 100 numbers and loop them: **1 to 100** or **301 to 400** or **0.1 to 10** or **0.01 to 1** or **- 49 to 50**
- Using your first window (it can be any colour):
 - a) place it on this worksheet making sure the squares match up. Write the missing numbers on the worksheet.
 - b) spin (rotate) your window a quarter turn (90°) to the next edge. Write the missing numbers on the worksheet again.
 - c) Continue to spin the window and write the missing numbers until you have placed all 4 edges at the top of the sheet.
- Use a different coloured window to write more missing numbers. Remember to spin it three times.
- Use the third coloured window to complete your one hundred numbers on the chart.
